TAKE ME OUT TO THE BALLGAME!!

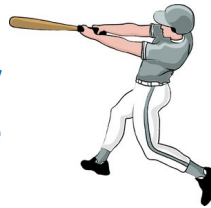
City Hall will be closed on Monday, July 4th in observance of holiday.
