### LEAF & LIMB REMOVAL

## **CITY OF STATHAM RESIDENTS ONLY**

The City will no longer be able to remove EXCESSIVE amounts of limbs and debris. Excessive amounts will result in a charge that will have to be pre-paid before removal. The City will continue to pick up minimal yard maintenance debris such as small limbs and trimmings. Please make sure to stack your debris lengthwise at the road, no longer than 12ft lengths. Do not place debris under power lines or phone lines.
