
The Statham Police Dept would like to thank the citizens for their generous donations for Adventure Bags even during the Pandemic.

This service is available for branches under 4 inches in diameter and 4 feet in length. Your pile needs to be no higher than 3 feet by 4 feet. Please place at the edge of the road and away from power lines, and call City Hall to request a pick-up, 770-725-5455. We will be glad to quote you a price on larger jobs.

WATER BILL

DATES TO REMEMBER Your water bill is due on the 15th of each month, on the 16th there will be a 10% late fee added. If your bill is not paid in full on or by the 20th, you will be subject to disconnection on the 21st.

WATER METERS Please be aware that water meters have antennas. Please mow cautiously around the meters to avoid damage. <u>Damage to the meters will result in a charge of \$185 or greater.</u>

LIMB PICK-UP This service is available for branches under 4 inches in diameter and 4 feet long. Your pile needs to be no higher than 3 feet by 4 feet. Please place at the edge of the road, away from power lines and call City Hall to request a pick up, 770-725-5455. We will be glad to quote you a price on larger jobs, just give us a call.
